



UNDER GRADUATE - HONOURS PROGRAM



A candidate shall be allowed to take admission in the Honours Program course of B.A / B.Sc / B.Com / BBA / BCA, if one has passed in at least FOUR subjects excluding Environmental Studies with English as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary (10 + 2) examinations with (a) 55% in the aggregate, or (b) 50% in the aggregate and with 60% marks in the desired Honours subject.



A candidate shall NOT be allowed to pursue B.A / B.Sc / B.Com Honours program course if one has passed the qualifying examination in Vocational Streams subjects.

UNDER GRADUATE - PROGRAM

FORMERLY CALLED GENERAL



A candidate shall be allowed to take admission in the Program course of B.A / B.Sc / B.Com, if one has passed in at least FOUR subjects excluding Environmental Studies with English as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary (10 + 2) examinations.



A candidate shall be allowed to pursue ONLY B.A / B.Sc / B.Com program course if one has passed the qualifying examination in Vocational Streams subjects.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE 2022 - 2023



Log in to the college website and fill up the application form as per the given instructions.



Selected list, purely made on the basis of merit, will be published on the college website and notice board. Students are advised to check the college website frequently for all the college related updates.



Selected students are to pay the admission fees through online payment mode to the designated bank in the college website portal within the stipulated time.



Based on the availability of seats a second or third list will be published.

ADMISSION FORM FILLING

A student may apply for more than one stream / subject but each application is to be made through separate online application forms with separate phone numbers.



- 1. Application forms are to be filled in and submitted only online through the College website www.sjcdarjeeling.edu.in
- 2. College will not be responsible for unsuccessful uploading of documents listed in No. 5
- 3. Ensure to take a printout of the filled-in application form after successful online submission, including documents the listed in No 5
- 4. Any wrong entry or manipulation in the application form (in marks obtained in class XII or in the categories) will result in the cancellation of the form and the admission.
- 5. Documents to be uploaded compulsorily at the time of form filling up.
 - a. Class XII Mark Sheet
 - b. Class XII Admit Card
 - c. Class X Admit Card
 - d. Caste Certificate (if applicable)
 - e. Letter from Parish Priests for Catholic Students (if applicable)

- The selection of the candidates will be done purely on merit basis and availability of seats.
- The list of candidates selected for admission will be published through the College Website and College Notice Board.
- Appearance of name in the merit list alone does not necessarily assure the right of admission in the applied courses.
- have only Candidates who applied for the B.A / B.Sc. / B.Com / BBA / BCA HONOURS **PROGRAM** will not considered for admission in the B.A / B.Sc. / B.Com PROGRAM (formerly known as General they Courses), if are selected the Honours Program of their choices. For consideration in the merit list of the B.A / B.Sc. / B.Com Program, a candidate has to apply separately for the same.

MERIT LIST



PAYMENT OF COLLEGE ADMISSION FEE

- Selected students are to pay the admission fee only through online payment mode (e-payment and not physical) to the designated bank through the college website portal.
- Fee paid to a non-designated Bank and/or after the last date, will not be considered as validation for admission and the college will hold no responsibility for any incorrect fee payment made.
- Payment of fees on the stipulated dates is mandatory, otherwise his/ her candidature will be cancelled and those who are in the waiting list will be called for admission.
- In case of any discrepancy found, during the verification of admission related documents or later in the University registration process, the candidature of the concerned candidate will be cancelled and all fees will be forfeited.
